



# COVID-19 Emergency Assistance Application

For Currently Enrolled Students

The COVID-19 Emergency Assistance fund helps with education-related expenses associated with the disruption of campus operations due to COVID-19. This fund is reserved for students who are currently enrolled in one of the U.S.-based on campus program. At this time the maximum amount of emergency assistance that will be provided by this grant is \$2,000. This funding is limited to students who are eligible to receive federal financial aid or who are eligible to file a FAFSA (are U.S. citizens or eligible noncitizens; have a valid Social Security number; have registered with the U.S. Selective Service if the student is male; have a high school diploma or GED, or have completed high school in an approved homeschool setting). Students are encouraged to apply no later than December 01, 2021 or until the fund is exhausted.

An enrolled student is defined as a student who has signed the enrollment agreement and has started instruction in the GIA U.S.-based on campus Title IV approved Program; Graduate Gemologist Program (GG), Graduate Jeweler Program (GJ), Jewelry Design & Technology Program (JDT) or Non-Title IV approved and accredited by ACCSC program; Graduate Diamond Program (GD), Graduate Colored Stones Program (GCS), Jewelry Design (JD) or Comprehensive CAD/CAM for Jewelry (CCC). For Carlsbad Campus, student who signed the enrollment agreement; has started instruction and not yet graduated as of 03/16/2020 or after; For New York Campus, student who signed the enrollment agreement; has started instruction or after and not yet graduated as of 03/12/2020 are consider as "enrolled" student.
