



CARLSBAD

Terms to be familiar with

| Amenitites | Refers to such things as a swimming pool, jacuzzi, laundry room, etc. | | |

| Application Fee | An administrative fee that may be charged to cover the costs of processing rental application. | | |
| Credit Check | An investigation in the terms of a report on one's history of borrowing and repaying money. | | |
| Furnished | A furnished apartment has furniture (dishes, table, chairs, sofa, bed, etc.) unfurnished apartment usually has only a refrigerator, stove and oven. | | |
| Landlord | The owner of an apartment/house. | | |
| Lease | A contract stating that you will live in an apartment for a specific period of time. If you move out before the end of the Lease, you will usually lose your security deposit. | | |
| Manager | The person who manages the apartment/house. | | |
| Rental Application | A form that provides the information necessary for a landlord or property owner to determine a tenant's creditworthiness and their ability to pay their rent reliably. | | |
| Renter's Insurance | Many apartment complexes require their tenants to carry a certain amount of renters insurance coverage. This will not only protect your belongings from theft, but also from natural disasters such as flood or fire. | | |
| Security Deposit | An amount of money paid to the Landlord as a guarantee that you will leave the apartment in similar condition as when it was rented to you. | | |
| Tenant | You, the renter. | | |
| Thirty Days Notice | On a month-to-month lease, this is the notice that either party must give to the other to terminate the tenancy. | | |
| Utilities | The monthly gas and electric bills that the tenant pays each month. | | |

Questions to ask yourself

- 1. How much can I spend on housing?
- 2. Do I want to live with a roommate?
- 3. How far is the space from school? Is it close to a bus stop?

Questions to ask the Manager or Landlord

- 1. How much is rent?
- 2. How much is the Security Deposit?
- 3. What type of rental agreement is this? (month-to-month, 6 month lease, etc.)
- 4. Are any utilities included in the price for rent?
- 5. Is there parking available?
- 6. Does the space come furnished?

GIA's campus has parking for more than 1,000 vehicles, electric car charging stations, bike racks and access to public transportation. Public transportation to the Carlsbad campus is limited and although bicycles are an alternative, a car is recommended.

Breeze

A fixed-route bus network that provides service throughout North County. The nearest BREEZE stop is just outside GIA! The 444 BREEZE bus is available for transportation (location pointed out on the above map).

Coaster

A commuter rail service that operates between Oceanside and San Diego. There are 8 station stops, taking approximately 62 minutes to complete the full length of a one-way trip.

LIFT, Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA)

A Paratransit Service, which provides origin-to-destination public transportation to eligible customers whose disabilities prevent them from using fixed-route bus and rail for some trips.

Sprinter

The east-west Sprinter light rail train system connecting Oceanside, Vista, San Marcos and Escondido. The 22-mile long rail system runs along the Highway 78 corridor, serving 15 stations and running every 30 minutes. It takes approximately 53 minutes to complete the full length of a one-way trip. The Sprinter has the same schedule year-round with late-night service on Friday/Saturday.



Transportation Tips



PRONTO is the North Country Transit District (NCTD) and Metropolitan Transit System (MTS) regional fare payment system. Riders can use the PRONTO app or a PRONTO card to ride NCTD buses and trains. Simply load money to your PRONTO card or app account, then tap or scan every time you ride.



PRONTO Card

Go to any COASTER or SPRINTER station ticket machine, any NCTD Customer Service Center, or find a retail location near you at RidePRONTO.com. Riders with a PRONTO card are encouraged to register their card online at RidePRONTO.com, over the phone with PRONTO Support (619-595-5636) or in-person at any NCTD Customer Service Center.

Registering your PRONTO card is the only way to protects its balance if the card gets lost or stolen.


Transportation



Public transportation is an option available to the GIA campus as well as the trails surrounding the area. The Armada Dr. Trail and the Legoland Trail are the two nearest trails along GIA.

The Legoland Trail is a paved multi-use flat trail adjacent to Legoland Park. The trail can be used by all ages and abilities because of the relative flat grade and paved smooth surface along its entire stretch. There is kiosk at The Crossings Dr. trailhead entrance with information about the trail.

The Armada Dr. Trail offers panoramic views of the flower fields and Pacific Ocean. There are several scenic points along this trail with grassy areas and many benches for relaxation and taking in the views. The southwest end of the trail is located near the intersection of Armada and Legoland Drive. This wide path is mainly flat with minor grade changes. There is a concrete ramp on the east end of trail near the entrance of Grand Pacific Palisades.

The City of Carlsbad has approximately 67 miles of trails and 51 miles of open space trails, supporting a healthy active lifestyle while protecting and preserving open space for residents to enjoy. Many trails also provide connections from neighborhoods to shops and local services.
