^bYears given are the issue date of the patent. A plus sign (+) means the author believes the cut is patented, based on reference(s) listed but could not confirm that fact by searching U.S. patent records (some of these are likely patent pending but as yet unpublished). A blank line means the author believes the cut is not patented based on reference(s) listed, but could not confirm that fact through other research. "Pending" means that the manufacturer has confirmed that an application has been filed. Patent data are as of April 2004. See References for specific patent numbers.

^cTrademark registration data as of April 2004. "Yes" entries include active applications in addition to registrations, and also include registrations in countries that are members of the Madrid Protocol, as these registrations are effective in the U.S. Entries marked "no" include expired, cancelled, and abandoned marks in addition to marks never registered. Note well that mere absence or abandonment of registration does *not* affect the ownership or validity of the trademark itself.
