Disclosures and Definitions

Calculation Methodology	This report comprises GIA's distance education students whose residence is in Massachusetts and who enrolled in (started) courses scheduled to end in each of the latest two calendar years (2015 and 2016).
Graduate Placement Rate	The percentage of graduates who obtained full-time and non-temporary employment in the field of study during each of the latest two calendar years for which the school has obtained verification, divided by the number of all students graduating from the course during each of the latest two calendar years. Employment statistics substantiating these placement rates are available for inspection on request.
Graduation Rate	The percentage of graduates during each of the latest two calendar years, divided by the number of students who enrolled in (started) the course during each of the latest two calendar years.
Median Graduation Time	The median duration of attendance in months, rounded to the nearest month, of all graduates during each of the latest two calendar years.
Number of Graduates	The number of students who successfully completed the course and were awarded a certificate during each of the latest two calendar years.
Number of Graduates Employed	The number of graduates who obtained full time and non-temporary employment in the field of study during each of the latest two calendar years for which the school has obtained verification.
Number of Students Enrolled	The total number of students who started the course during each of the latest two calendar years.
Total Cost of the Course	The tuition and fees charged for completing a course including the typical costs for books and supplies (unless those costs are included as part of tuition and fees) the cost of room and board (whether on or off campus), and transportation.
